

Bring a Friend Alternatives

The purpose of AWANA is to share the Gospel with boys and girls so they can hear about God's love for them. Each handbook has a "bring a friend" section. While we'd like our clubbers to bring a friend to club and hear the gospel, it sometimes does not work out.

Here are some club approved alternatives:

- Write AWANA invitation postcards to friends. Bring the addressed cards to AWANA for your leader to see, and then mail them.
- Bring friends to Sunday School or another program at church. Have your parent put a note in your handbook stating the event name and date.
- Write a letter to a friend explaining AWANA. Give a sample salvation message and an invitation to AWANA. Bring the letter, with a stamped envelope so your leader can read it and then mail it to your friend.

Cubbies

- 3-4 year olds (the two years before Kindergarten)
- Needs to be potty trained to attend
- \$15 for the whole year. Includes vest, book, and handbag.



Sparks

- Kindergarten – 2nd Grade
- \$15 for the whole year. Includes vest, book, and handbag.



Truth and Training (T&T)

- 3rd – 6th Grades
- \$15 for the whole year. Includes vest, book, and handbag.



Clubbers will receive their vest and book after they complete their entrance exam. Payment can be made anytime during the first month of participation.

The Cancellation of Club

AWANA Uniform

Upon completing the entrance booklet, each clubber is eligible to receive an official AWANA uniform. Each AWANA Club has a different uniform.

- Cubbies | Blue Vest
- Sparks | Red Vest
- T&T | Green t-shirt

Be sure to size the uniform appropriately to use throughout your child's time in that particular group. Clubbers can earn Awana Bucks for wearing their uniform.

Game Time

Game Time is the club segment when clubbers enjoy fun games on the unique AWANA game circle. Sparks and T & T will be assigned one of the four team colors (red, blue, green, or yellow) to play games. Visitors will be placed on the color team of the person that invited them.

General Expectations

- Pushing, shoving, and roughhousing are not allowed.
- Running is only allowed during games.
- Language is to be positive and uplifting and negative humor is to be avoided.
- Questionable or improper language (including profanity and rudeness) is not acceptable.
- Each person is fully responsible for all personal items; valuables and toys should be left at home.
- Church facilities should be cared for and items should be put away after each use.
- All leaders, workers, and other adults will be respected at all times.
- To avoid interrupting segments of the night, restroom breaks need to be completed before segments begin.

Clubber Expectations

During Game time

- Good sportsmanship and participation are encouraged.
- Clubbers must stay behind their team color line or assigned area.
- Clubbers need to listen for instructions, cheer for their team, and have fun!
- Wear or bring tennis shoes.

During Handbook Time

- Bibles and handbooks are needed every AWANA night (unless specifically noted).
- If the clubber is not working on a section with a leader, they should be studying independently in their handbook.
- When talking, clubbers should keep it down to a whisper so as not to disturb others.

During Council Time

- Clubbers are expected to be quiet, except when called upon.
- Everyone is encouraged to participate in the lesson (fill in your book with the answers, answer questions and participate as asked).
- Stay in seats unless directed otherwise.
- Don't be disruptive to others.

Clubber Responsibilities

- Bring Bible and handbook each week.
- Have sections learned in your handbook.
- Participate at Game Time.
- Invite friends to come with you.

Handbook Time

Handbook time is when leaders listen to verses and assist clubbers in memorizing God's Word.

At the beginning of the club year new clubbers will be given an entrance booklet of general information and material to be memorized. Once they have passed the requirements of this booklet, they will receive their AWANA handbook.

It is very important that parents encourage and work with their children in their books. The clubber must work at home throughout the week in preparation for the AWANA Club meeting. Sections of the handbook must be passed in their entirety in one sitting. This includes definitions and questions. Each section can have two helps. Sparks should aim to pass two sections a week to complete their book. T&T have one section to complete each week (not counting the review sections which will have to be done as well). The T&T group also have optional Gold and Silver sections. If your child is going to do the gold and silver extra credit sections, this is something they should work on at home and have ready when they come to club each week.

In Sparks and T&T, if a clubber does not pass a section in two weeks, he or she will forfeit their Game Time until a section is complete.

Awana Store

Clubbers will have the opportunity to shop at the AWANA Store with their hard earned AWANA Bucks 4 times throughout the year! This is how your child can earn bucks: \$1 buck for attending, bringing their handbook, bringing their bible, wearing their uniform, special dress up days, and winning in game time.
\$2 bucks for every section passed
\$5 bucks for bringing a friend
